1. Read Romans 8:1, 2 Corinthians 5:10 and 2 Timothy 4:1. Do you ever think of Jesus as Judge? What kind of Judge do you imagine Jesus to be? What expectations do you have of Jesus as Judge?
2. Read Luke 18:9-14. How did Jesus' attitude toward sinners differ with the Pharisees? Do people still struggle with self-righteous judgmentalism today? Do you see yourself in need of mercy as much as any sinner in the city?
3. In light of Exodus 31:18, it appears Jesus is revealing Himself as the Giver of the Law when He is described in John 8:6 as writing with His finger. How does this impact your view of Jesus?
4. Review Jesus' words to the woman in John 8:11. What do you think is significant about the order of His words? What would be the implication if His words were reversed? How great is God's grace?
