



RLG Apprentice

Description:

An Apprentice Shepherd is to assist the group leader in shepherding the small group for the purpose of learning how to lead a group when the group multiplies or as need arises when additional groups are launched. This position is intended to be a 1 or 2 year position, resulting in an apprentice becoming a Shepherd.

PROFILE:

Walk with God – Growing in a close personal relationship with Jesus Christ, growing in Biblical character, and learning to live out the Greatest Commandment (LOVE GOD)

Work with People – Learning to lead and serve incarnationally by living out the 2nd Greatest Commandment (LOVE PEOPLE)

Accomplish the Mission – Learning to lead people into CONNECTING RELATIONALLY, GROWING SPIRITUALLY, and LIVING MISSIONALLY. living out the Great Commission (MAKE DISCIPLES)

Live as Learners – Learning to be self-aware, pursuing personal growth and improvement in leadership position skills; humbly accepting feedback as you prepare to lead your own group. (CONSTANT EVALUATION)

RESPONSIBILITIES:

WEEKLY:

- Pray daily for your group.
- Prepare well for your group time and pray prior to the meeting.
- Faithfully attend and engage during group.
- Engage with weekly communication through email and social media.

MONTHLY:

- Attend RLG Connect
- Connect 1:1 with leader of the group

ANNUALLY:

- Discipleship Commissioning's (Sept., Jan.)
- Annually – Attend and be involved with Church-wide events (ex. Drive, Baptism, City-wide campaigns, Shift....)
- Identify, recruit, and make disciples.
