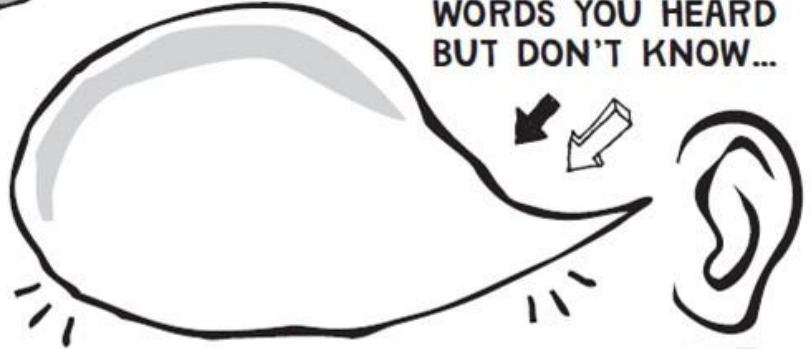

Peter asked Jesus if he should forgive someone seven times. Jesus answered, "Not seven times but seventy times seven."

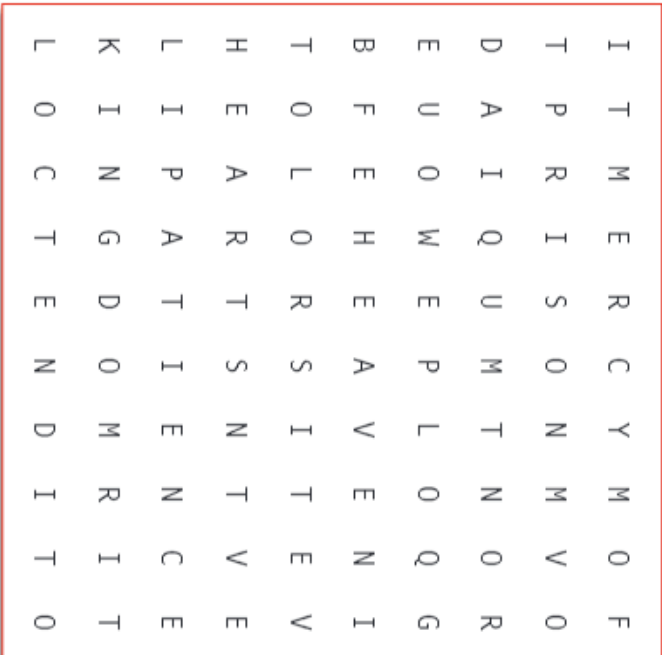
We should go on-forgiving if a person is sorry for what he or she has done.


The Story of the Forgiving King Word Search

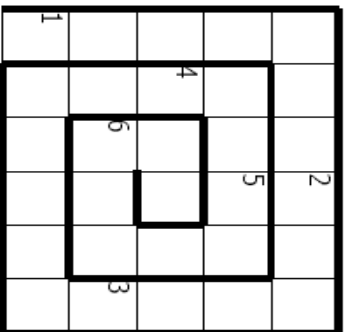
